#### **Quick Recipe: French Toast:**

Ingredients (serves 2-4)

4 eggs

Olive Oil

4 slice of bread

Chopped Fruit and/or nuts to serve

- 1. Crack all four eggs in a bowl and beat
- 2. Heat the oil in a frying pan
- 3. When the oil is hot, dip one piece of bread in the egg, coating both sides it's easier to do this if the egg is in a flat dish, for example a small baking tray
- 4. Transfer the soaked bread to the hot pan and leave it to cook for 1-2 minutes, turn it over and cook the other side
- 5. Once finished set to one side and repeat with the rest of the bread
- 6. Serve the eggy bread with chopped fruit and/or nuts
