Barbeque Banana Boats

Ingredients—per person

- 1 ripe firm bananas, unpeeled
- 1 tbls chocolate chips
- 1 tbls miniature marshmallows 1/2 tsp chopped pecans

Method

Cut 6 (12-inch) sheets of heavy-duty foil. Heat barbeque

With sharp knife, make deep lengthwise cut along inside curve of each banana, being careful not to cut all the way through. Open slit to form pocket. Crimp and shape 1 sheet of foil around each banana, forming boats.

Holding each banana in hand, fill pocket with 1 tablespoons chocolate chips, 1 tablespoons marshmallows and about 1/2 heaping teaspoon chopped pecans.

Return each banana to its foil boat. Seal top of foil, leaving 2 to 3 inches headspace. Place on bbq until marshmallows soften. Approx. 15 to 20 minutes in oven until marshmallows soften

These can also be cooked in the oven or under a grill
